2. Participants will submit 5 images of their artwork (photos saved in pdf or jpg format) via Google Drive Folder (or similar Folder Sharing service) or as attachments to the email. Folders should be made public/available to those provided with a link. **Link to the Public Folder must be sent with the participant's application to oldfort@albany.twcbc.com.**
3. All Submitted work must be original and created by the participating student that enters it.
4. Files in Public Shared Folders submitted for judging must be labeled in the following format:
