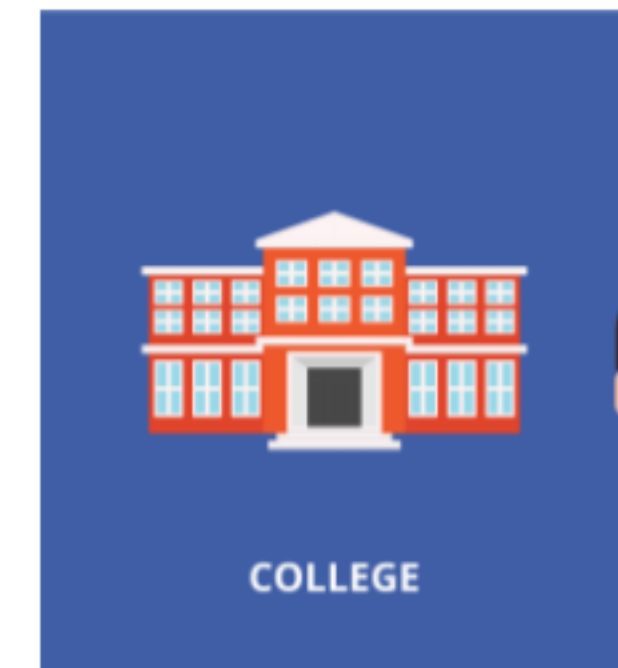
## AP Coursework
